
Annual Report 2016

Judea Harvest encompasses three distinct and related ministry strategy platforms: Judea Harvest, Judea Hope, and Judea Training. Each devision is explained in detail in this report.

The past seventeen years have been such an incredible journey for Judea Harvest! In February of 1999 we started deploying our first tents in all the provinces of South Africa. The dream was big and very daunting, fill Africa with harvesting machines, "crusade tents" and the goal was set at 3000 tents to be deployed. This would translate into reaching a million people for Christ! Dr Bruce Wilkinson once said, the size of your vision and goals must match with the size of the need you are addressing!

This is where Judea Harvest constantly finds ourselves in troubled waters! The size of our dream and goals scares us daily! However the size of the need in Africa is enormous! Connected with the openness and receptiveness of the people of Africa to the Gospel provides us with a very unique opportunity!

We have a burning desire to reach, disciple and plant this masses of people into new Churches! We need to complete the Great Commission in our part of the world in this Generation!

During the second part of 2016 we plan to dedicate tent 3 000! What a great occasion to the Glory of our Lord will that not be!

Well we dream to deploy one new tent every working day of the year! Then we plan to build a Snap Church every week, and train our network of students in 1 000 courses every week! Bibles

There is nothing more powerful to help people know God and build a relationship through discipleship. In the last year we have given a free bible to every new convert in Judea Harvest outreach projects and churches. These Bibles are provided in the local language of the region and \pm 25 000 Bibles are distributed annually. In January 2016, Judea Harvest delivered 25 000 French Bibles to the harbour in Lomé, Togo, West Africa.

Audio Discipleship Course

For those who cannot read, a solar powered Audio Bible in the native language is provided. With the help of the MBC (Mini Bible College), provided by ICM, an audio based discipleship bible study course has been placed in every Judea Harvest church. This course consists of 215 lessons on the bible. People listen to the lessons and then participate in discussion groups.



Taking Church Planting to West Africa

he John Journey evangelism strategy is now in the third year of roll-out. The results are very encouraging and we are pleased to report that the strategy has been adopted by the local leaders as their own. They are now replicating and scaling the project by doing John Journey seminars on their own. The focus of these efforts is in the unreached rural areas.

John Journey is now an active Church Planting strategy in the following countries:

- Cameroon 36 new churches 43 new churches - Benin - Togo 163 new churches - Burkina Faso 24 new churches - Chad 7 new churches - Niger 8 new chucrhes - Sierra Leone 27 new churches



John Journey church planter's bibles have been printed and delivered to West Africa to aid the church planters. The John Journey church planters bible gives the church planters a valuable tool with which to pastor, practice discipleship, and plant churches.

Taking Church Doors to The People

igwedge Ithough God is omnipresent and can be found anywhere if you call out to Him, we realise that when people look for God they come to the church building. God knocks on our hearts' doors, but if people want to knock on God's door, the come and knock on the church door. We also came to realise that as soon as a new church has been successfully planted it needs a home. A church building provides such a home.

Judea Harvest has embarked on a project to assist successful church plants to build new buildings. Judea Harvest enters into a partnership with such an assembly to build a building of 120 m². In 2015 we managed to build 12 churches.







n 2016 Judea Harvest is building 2 churches per month in South Africa as well as additional churches every month in the SADEK countries surrounding South Africa. Currently we have ongoing building projects in the neighbouring countries.



ay care centres and feeding

One of the major needs that we focused on was the creation of day care centres for thousands of children that had no place to learn, play and eat. Through collaboration with religious and civic groups we have established 1000

informal day care centres that also serve as an ideal platform for the distribution of food.

Unique nutritional approach

Through research and consultation with local nutritional experts Judea Hope (www.judeahope.org) has formulated a dehydrated rice, vegetable and legume based meal that provides all the macronutrient needs for a child and even an adult. To enhance the nutritional potency of the meal further a vitamin and mineral sachet was specifically formulated for the meal pack and is included in the packaging. This is added after the meal has been cooked. Soon after we had rolled out the first batches of food with our vitamin sachet anecdotal feedback started rolling in. There are too many testimonies to note in this document but feedback ranges from decreased illnesses amongst the children to improved general health of people living with HIV.

Sadly due to the overwhelming need we are currently only managing 3 meals per week at some of the 1000 day care centres.

Unique participatory approach

Since the meals have to be packed, we opted to invite companies to not just donate financially but to invite their staff to become involved as volunteer meal packers. This is done through a fun and engaging assembly line process where staff members pack the meals that their company has donated.





On request we can also facilitate the production of a short, fun video that organisations can use on their intranet and other marketing channels.

More Than A Million Meals Project

Judea Hope is planning to pack more than a million meals in various packing events across South Africa in 2016. The meals are packed by volunteers from the corporates, churches, and schools that donate R30 000 for 70 boxes of food; packing 20 000 meals in 3 hours. The meals are easy to transport, store and distribute to those in need.

Food for the brain

Besides the food packs Judea Hope provides the day care centres with training material and the staff also receives basic literacy courses at university standard. All the material for children development is also supplied to the teachers

BBBEE and Article 18 certificates

Judea Hope is a registered NPO and has an Article 18a tax certification. Donations to the Judea Hope feeding scheme therefore qualifies for the BBBEE scorecard.

aking Traing To The People.
That is what Judea Training is all about. Since the launch of Judea Training in 2013, Judea Training in partnership with Teach Every Nation (TEN) have trained more than 17 000 students who have completed more than 50 000 courses.

The Judea Training and TEN partnership went through a few changes since 2013. The motivation behind these changes was to make the training more accessible and more cost effective. At first the students received their training via a closed Sattelite Simulcast System on TV. Each student registered online and received a workbook at the TEN campus. Students were directed by the Dean and paid the fee of R100 either to the Dean or into the Judea Training bank acc. The simulcast happened on selected Saturdays. Soon the partnership realised that the Closed Satellite Simulcast was very expensive and then it converted to a closed decoder arrangement while the workbooks became available in PDF format. This was also not without challenges as the decoder system was interrupted severely by weather conditions. The last alteration happened at the end of 2015 and now (2016) Judea Training became available on DVD's and workbooks were introduced again.
